overdose calls to which Emergency Medical Services (EMS) responded in Rhode Island

Providence, R.I., (April 15, 2019) - Naloxone is a medication designed to rapidly reverse opioid overdose and studies show that increased access to naloxone is an effective way to fight overdose deaths.

Through the development and distribution of NaloxBox as a nonprofit effort among partner agencies, RI is in a unique position to provide an innovative solution to address the crisis nationwide. The NaloxBox mission is important and simple: increase access, reduce stigma, and save lives.

On Wednesday, April 17th at 11AM the staff of the Dunkin' Donuts Center & Rhode Island Convention Center will participate in naloxone training. The training is designed to prepare individuals to recognize and respond to an overdose.
